Description: Clay tobacco pipe mark index, compiled by Adrian Oswald.

Comments: These are marks with an E surname initial. Arranged alphabetically by Surname (i.e. AE, BE, CE, DE etc.). Each section starts with a typed list of giving details, including provenance for each piece, which have an identifying number that is a simple sequence of numbers (i.e. 1, 2, 3 etc.) occasionally with sub-lists, if there are more than one example (i.e. 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, etc).




Figure 11: Makers' marks: heels a-k; bowl marks l-aa
