Description: Clay tobacco pipe mark index, compiled by Adrian Oswald.

Comments: These are marks with a K surname initial. Arranged alphabetically by Surname (i.e. AK, BK, CK, DK, etc.). Each section starts with a typed list giving details, including provenance for each piece, which have an identifying number that is a simple sequence of numbers (i.e. 1, 2, 3, etc.) occasionally with sub-lists, if there are more than one example (i.e. 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, etc.).




