




C1/C2 - This pipe, with abroken stem, repaired with a "silver" and "ivory" (white metal and bone I guess) mouthpiece, was given me by a lady in Whitchurch, Bucks, in a case which nearly fitted it, but pretty clearly was not original. She knew nothing of its origin. The stem had been wrapped round with thread, and the white metal tube forced over it. The bone mouthpiece screwed into the metal. Lettering was just visible. Removal of the tube and the thread resulted in one piece of stem disintegrating, but photographs of the two sides show that the pipe was marked "T.MILO - STRAND". Do you know anything of this marked "T.MILO - STRAND" be merely advertising a shop.
