Each section starts with a typed list giving details, including provenance for each piece, which have an identifying number that is a simple sequence of numbers (i.e. 1, 2, 3, etc.) occasionally with sub-lists, if there are more than one example (i.e. 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, etc.).

Numbered Pipes From Wapping, London. S. N. W. W. H3/T and H7/T, mould-imparted. Bases smooth. S.B.D.'s 2 mm. Bowls drawn I:I. From a group found on the river shore. Companion pipes include similar diminished L.25 bowls marked H/T with heart motifs, one lettered I/T, along with transitional I8th/I9th century pointed-spur types, some marked M/T with hearts. Probably a local family concern. The two bowls illustrated seem to represent some of the earlier forms, perhaps made c.I750 or slightly before. A standard size L.25 found with the group lettered H/T, though without numbers, again suggests this period. Similarly marked H/T heart bowls have found in Oslo and placed in a I700-40

context.3

Perhaps the spur numbers represented individuals' work within the family pipe-shop, to keep check on the quality of goods produced and record the output; or to indicate separate customers' orders, i.e. a type of distribution or destination mark. Possibly they were pipe-mould or 'model' numbers for customers and dealers themselves to order by. But this seems unlikely with the two bowls illustrated as there is little to choose between them in quality, size or shape. Unless their stems were of varying lengths.

Notes.

Cartouche marks began c1690 and Jane Tippett's could be 1688 but generally speaking the decade of 1690-1700 marks their start. Some certainly are sprigged on and not mould imparted.

Names round the dge of the cartouche begin about 1700. The HH stamping on a circular mark of R.TIPPET might imply this occured after R.Tippet's(2) death for Hoar started taking apprentices after 1716 but equally it may imply a partnership with his old master.

Some of the back of bowl RT marks e.g. those on Isaac Evans pipes may well belong to Robert Tippett(3)

Drawings from Port Royal and Jackson and Price do not distinguish relief from incuse marks. Cartouche marks are normally relief.
