

Each section starts with a typed list giving details, including provenance for each piece, which have an identifying number that is a simple sequence of numbers (i.e. 1, 2, 3, etc.) occasionally with sub-lists, if there are more than one example (i.e. 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, etc.).

These pipes with the rare initial combination can hardly be any other maker and would indicate a period of manufacture from c1745-75.

Nos 3-5 indicate the use by Watts of the moulds of RB (v.RB) who might be Richard Bryant Who took apprentices between 1733-40, Robert Baldwin who polled at Westminster 1749 or perhaps more likely Richard Boucher of Belton St St Giles in the fields who took an insurance 1766. In any case it would seem Watts became a partner or took over the moulds c.1770. Nos 3 and 5 are apparently from the same mould with different overstamps. No 3 from the same deposit as 1 must surely be the same Watts but 4 and 5 mught represent a later descendant and No 6 is a typical pipe of c.1800.
