Description: Clay tobacco pipe mark index, compiled by Adrian Oswald.

Comments: These are marks with X-Y surname initial. Arranged alphabetically by Surname (i.e. AX, BX, CX, DX, etc.). Each section starts with a typed list giving details, including provenance for each piece, which have an identifying number that is a simple sequence of numbers (i.e. 1, 2, 3, etc.) occasionally with sub-lists, if there are more than one example (i.e. 1a, 1b, 1c, 2a, 2b, etc.).

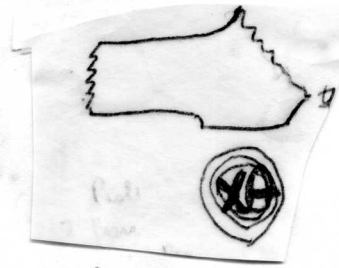

6. Pipe found in Little Canford Gravel Pit (near Wimborne). Small pipe with almost flat base and stem; mark of 2 initials on base in small circle: looked at the usual way up, it reads XD, (?), upside-down, CX (much more definite.) c. 1600-40; marks were rare at this date, which might account for its being upside-down. (1939. 36. 3.)



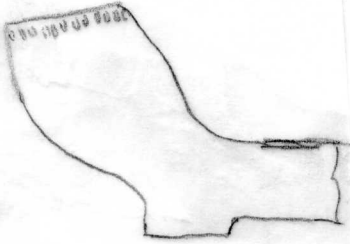
