# Southwark parishes searched by Peter John Hammond [PJH] January 2015

(mainly from registers browsable on www.ancestry.co.uk plus earlier research carried out at the Metropolitan Archives)

There was not time to search the parish of **St Thomas** (a quick check did not reveal any mention of occupations, but this needs to be assessed more thoroughly). Other parishes in Southwark pre-1800 are **St Giles, Camberwell** and **St Mary, Rotherhithe**, which again require assessing even if not searching in full. No search was made of **St Mary, Newington** as this has already been searched and published by Colin Tatman (BAR British Series 239, 1994).

#### **Christ Church, Southwark**

Baptisms: 1672-1722 and 1752-1789

Occupations listed from 1672. Searched in full to November 1722 when occupations cease to be listed. Occupations then listed again from 1752. Searched to 1789. Decided not to continue, as this parish was so unproductive! Only one reference found in hundreds of pages:

18<sup>th</sup> November 1759 – John, son of George Aldridge, pipe maker, and [\_\_\_\_\_ name not visible due to fold in page] his wife baptised.

[Numerous references to hat makers, glass makers, glass grinders, polishers of looking glasses, pot makers, and even a clerk to glass house]

Burials: 1672-1722

Occupations listed from 1672. Searched in full to October 1722 when occupations cease to be listed. No occupations mentioned in burials thereafter. Again, only one reference found in hundreds of pages:

Burials: 1698-1714

Occupations listed from 1698. Searched in full to mid 1714 when occupations cease to be listed due to the death of the clerk John Hopkins who seems to have been very meticulous, though addresses continue to be given thereafter. Occupations occasionally listed from 1760 to 1812 but a full search was not deemed viable at this stage due to the length of time it would take for limited results. A tobacco pipe mould maker also found which may be the earliest found to date!

## St Olave, Bermondsey

## St Saviour, Southwark

This parish turned out to be by far the most prolific historic parish within Southwark for clay pipe makers. Being a large parish and the registers largely referring to occupations throughout much of the relevant period, it proved to be very timeconsuming to search, but very productive.

Note that a few of those who are listed as tobacco pipe makers are also entered as tobacco box makers, and it is not clear whether they actually altered their occupations (which would seem unlikely) or whether the parish clerk has simply made an error when copying up the entries into the registers.

Not all the pipe makers listed will be master pipe makers; some will inevitably be journeymen. And the baptisms of course are restricted to those who married and had children, whereas the burials will include all.

Some of the surnames vary considerably – presumably depending on how the parish clerk heard their names in the first place.

I accept any responsibility for any transcription errors. Some of the registers are faint or blotched, rendering some entries very hard to read. Where it was certain of an unusual spelling 'sic' was entered to show that this is how it is written. Conversely where it was not sure if the spelling was interpreted correctly, then the entry has a question mark with or without a suggestion. In the case of multiple entries then it is usually possible to work out the correct name, but if it is a single entry for a particular pipe maker then some will have to remain as queries. To add to the confusion there are numerous pin makers and even pan makers – both of which can look like 'pipe maker' if the register is not clear. As far as it is aware though all those entries that definitely say 'pipe' or 'tobacco pipe' maker have been extracted except where the registers are too faint.

Baptisms: 1620-1733 inclusive

Some entries have been standardised so that they conform to the same format, and obvious misspellings such as 'tobacco pip' corrected. From 1733 onwards right through to 1812 the baptism registers are very faint and therefore generally extremely difficult to view. Nevertheless. a full search was still made of every page up to 1757 as two clerks had entered the details – one with atrocious handwriting and one with neat small writing which was generally discernible. A couple of possible pipe makers were therefore noted from 1733–1757 but their details have not been entered in the following, as the names cannot be identified with certainty. Ideally a search will be required of the original registers. Those from 1812 also still require searching.

Marriages: 1653-1657

For the period of the Commonwealth marriages occasionally list occupations. Occupations are not listed for the marriages before and after - until 1837.

Burials: 1654-1765 and 1777-1790

Occupations frequently listed for burials from May 1654 onwards. Note in 1717 and 1718 some pages are extremely faint and so not all entries may have been found. From 1733 to the 1750s, as with the baptisms, again there are two clerks entering the details but unlike the baptisms they are far more legible. Though one of the filmed registers on <u>www.ancestry.co.uk</u> states that it finishes in 1776, it actually ends in 1765. Then there is a gap in the filmed sequence to 1777. This has then been searched to 1790 inclusive so far, but still needs to be continued to 1812 as occupations frequently continue to be listed.

However, despite the fact that occupations are not always listed and also despite the baptisms largely being unreadable in this period, there is a very marked decline in the numbers of entries for pipe makers <u>after</u> the 1720s – thus suggesting there was an actual reduction in the numbers of pipe makers operating within the parish. This may well be due to them relocating and/or with changes in fashions; snuff box makers for example were noted for example in 1713 and 1718.
