2:3 THE 'IRISH PRICE LIST' OF D. McDOUGALL & Co.

D.B. Gallagher

A trade card of D. McDougall & Co. survives in the collection of the People's Palace Museum, Glasgow (PP 77. 232 and PP80.50). The front of this card, which is reproduced in Helm 1978, illustrates the factory at 277 Parliamentary Road, Glasgow under the legend of 'The Glasgow Pipe Manufactory'. The reverse shows the 'Irish Price List' which is reproduced below. It is intended for purchasers buying pipes at wholesale prices directly from McDougall & Co.

McDougall & Co operated from this Parliamentary Road address during the period 1851-88. References in the list to pipes named after Livingstone (no. 147) and Stanley (no. 148) were probably added after their famous African meeting in 1871. The list may be so dated by these names and the 1888 move of address to within the period 1871-88.
